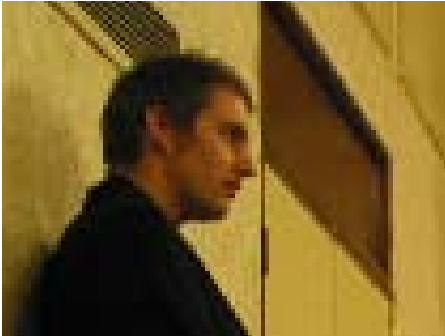

He has worked as an actor in the UK for Carlton, Thames and BBC1. He has performed overseas in film work for Pakistan, Sweden, Denmark, Holland and Germany. His feature films as an actor includes *The Odyssey*, *One Hell of A Christmas*, *Laaj* and Simon Hunter's *Lighthouse*.



He is a member of the Cornish Theatre Collective.

Pat has directed a number of shorts, is working on a television pilot and is in pre-production on his second full-length film, *This Woman's Work*, filming 2005 on location in Cornwall.

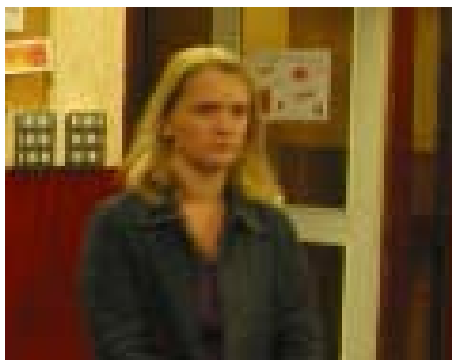
David Kershaw - Simon

Nikki Brown - Vicky

Nikki Brown is fast-rising on the UK Indie movie scene, starring in the recently completed *London Voodoo*. *Encounters* is her second feature. Theatre work includes *Odysseus / Chorus* in *Hecuba* (WAC and UK Tour) *Mamma / Louella* in *Stamping Shouting and Singing Home* (MAC Birmingham & UK Tour).

Jenna Shaw - Sue

Since graduating from Arts Ed, Jenna has worked mainly in the theatre, namely *Little Women* (Bloomsbury Theatre), *World Cafe* (Hampstead), *Songbirds Ltd* (Courtyard Theatre), *You're Gonna Love Tomorrow* (Greenwich Playhouse) and *The Treason Show* (Komedia, Brighton). *Encounters* is her first feature film.

Hannah Smith is a well-known leading actress in commercial and classical theatre around the UK, and is making her screen debut in *Encounters*.



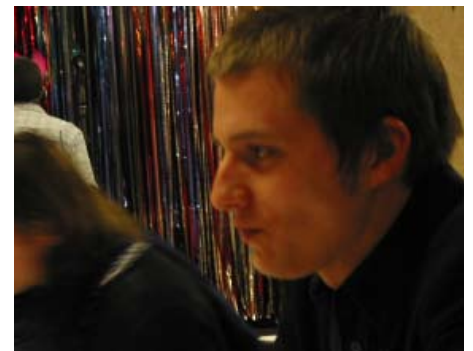
Matthew Worthington - Mateuz

Since completing *Encounters*, Patrick Thornton has been snapped up by the BBC to play a major role in *Undone*, and has also featured in *Fairytale: A True Story* directed by Charles Sturridge.



Deborah Jeffrey - Ruth

Deborah Jeffrey came to *Encounters* from her successful lead role in Frank Zappa's *Thing Fish*, and a run in Franco Zeffirelli's opera production of *Pagliacci*. Primetime British TV appearances include *The Office*, *EastEnders*, *The Bill*, *Murphy's Law* and *Red Cap*. She will next be seen in Mira Nair's film of *Vanity Fair*.



Jonty Reason - Producer

Encounters is Jonty Reason's second feature production, after the thriller *Red Mercury*. An established actor and screenwriter, he has moved into feature films after ten years of successfully directing theatre and short films.

He has produced two highly rated shorts in conjunction with *Encounters* director Pat Kelman, and continues to be in great demand as an actor.

He has just produced the feature *Camp X-Ray: Ghosts of Guantanamo*, and is in pre-production on his first feature as director, *For The Good of The People*.

He lives in the Docklands, the central location of *Encounters*.
